



## Laboratory Notice to Patients

The Women's Care Florida (WCF) Laboratory provides expert pathology analysis and complete continuity of care for our patients. A Board-Certified Pathologist with specialty expertise and fellowship training in Gynecological & Breast Pathology will be overseeing the processing of your pathology, clinical blood specimens and non-invasive prenatal screening. The Lab also performs molecular testing for infectious diseases and cervical cancer screening which includes pap smears and HPV testing.

The results will be available to your provider immediately after the specimens are processed. When necessary, there is direct communication between your Physician and lab Director.

You may receive a billing statement after your Insurer has processed your insurance claim just as you would if your specimen was sent to any laboratory. These charges are separate from your physician office or procedure charges and may be subject to deductibles and/or co-insurance based on your insurance coverage and benefits.

In cases where multiple laboratory tests are ordered by your provider, and one comes to the WCF Laboratory and the other(s) go to an outside commercial laboratory, you may receive a statement for the amount that is patient responsibility from two different laboratories.
